Veterans Day - Celebration Details

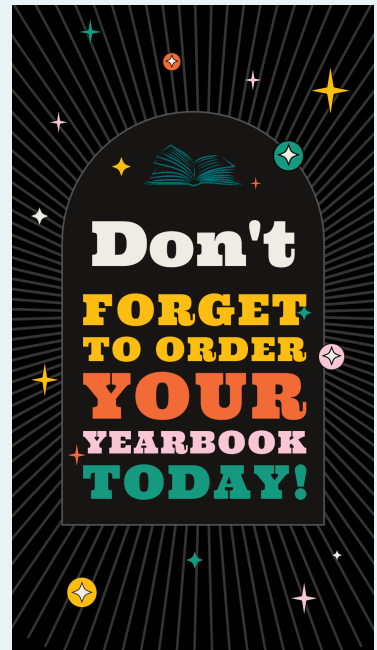
