6TH GRADE RE-ENROLLMENT

Hello 6th Grade families. We look forward to having your student at APA Draper 3 campus for the 2024-25 school year! It is time for re-enrollment at APA and because 6th grade students will be transferring to the Draper 3 campus next year, you will need to attend a re-enrollment meeting at D3 to complete the process for your 6th grade student. The dates for re-enrollment meetings at the D3 campus are as follows:

Wednesday, January 24th, 6 p.m.

Meetings will be held in the D3 multi-purpose room on the 3rd floor. Doors will be locked promptly at start time and there will be no late admittance. Please plan accordingly. These meetings are mandatory for ALL families every year.
