APA offers FREE lunches to students

Thanks to a USDA free meal waiver, American Preparatory Academy will begin offering lunch at no cost to all enrolled students who pre-order beginning Tuesday, September 15th at all school locations. All students are eligible, whether they are learning in the classroom, online or at home. **How to Order**

All families are asked to follow our normal procedures for ordering lunch:

- 1. Complete an application <u>https://www.americanprep.org/school-lunch-program/eligibility/</u> Regardless of your status, all lunches will be free.
- 2. Our school lunch staff will set up an account on our online ordering system.
- 3. Parents receive instructions to pre-order lunches one month at a time (currently through the end of September).

If you have already completed an application and would like to order free lunches, email <u>lunch@apamail.org</u> so we can set up an account for online ordering.

On Campus Students

Lunch is served to each elementary classroom, and in the Jr. High and High School cafeterias. All meals must be pre-ordered 48 hours in advance. Lunches are prepared off-site, and is not always available upon demand. All lunches are COLD sack lunches. Microwaves are available for secondary students.

Off Campus Students

Off Campus learners may pick up meals at specific times and locations as designated by each school. Additionally, these families may pick up meals for any siblings who are 18 years of age or younger. All meals must be pre-ordered 48 hours in advance.
