

Constitution Day



Constitution Day is on September 17th. We will have tryouts during lunch on August 28th for any students interested in reading a part of our constitution in our annual program this year. Tryouts will be in the gym during the student's lunch with Mrs. Brown and our Character Development Team.

*If your child had a speaking part in LAST year's constitution day live stream assembly, they will likely not be selected this year in order to give more students a chance to take part in this unique event. Thank you for your understanding.

K-3 should read this part at tryouts: PREAMBLE

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

4-6 should read this part at tryouts:

SECTION 6

The Senators and Representatives shall receive a Compensation for their Services, to be ascertained by Law, and paid out of the Treasury of the United States. They shall in all Cases, except Treason, Felony and Breach of the Peace, be privileged from Arrest during their Attendance at the Session of their respective Houses, and in going to and returning from the same; and for any Speech or Debate in either House, they shall not be questioned in any other Place

No Senator or Representative shall, during the Time for which he was elected, be appointed to any civil Office under the Authority of the United States, which shall have been created, or the Emoluments whereof shall have been increased during such time; and no Person holding any Office under the United States, shall be a Member of either House during his Continuance in Office.
